

**Directions and Map to

By Train

Trains from London Waterloo go via Clapham Junction, leave every hour and take approx 2 hours and 20 minutes to Sherborne. There is a taxi rank right outside Sherborne station (Beaver Cabs tel 01935 816620) and it takes about 10 minutes from there to the house. The last train leaves London at 21.20

Trains from London Paddington to Castle Cary take approx 2 hours but are generally more expensive. Call a taxi from Castle Cary station (approx 15 minutes to the house).

By Air

Nearest airports are Bristol, Bournemouth, Southampton or Exeter, all approx 1 hour away. Bristol and Bournemouth airports are best reached by car, but Exeter and Southampton have good connections via rail to Sherborne.

Heathrow airport (approx 2 hours away) is easy to reach by car or train (take the Heathrow express bus from Heathrow bus station and change at Woking rail station)

Gatwick airport is approx 3 hours away. Take the train towards London and change at Clapham Junction. Go to platform 9 for the trains to Sherborne

Stansted airport is approx 4 hours away. Take the Stansted express train towards London Liverpool Street. Change at Tottenham Hale station onto the Victoria Line. Get off at Victoria or Vauxhall and catch a mainline train to Clapham Junction. Go to platform 9 for the trains to Sherborne.

London City airport is approx 3 hours away. Take the Docklands Light Railway and then the Jubilee Line to Waterloo then the train to Sherborne.

By Coach

National Express run coaches that go through Yeovil (approx 10 miles away). Berry's Bus runs a fast express service from Hammersmith Bus Station (London) (easy connections to central London and Heathrow airport via the Piccadilly Line) to Wincanton (approx 2 hours). However, you do need to book in advance – tel 01823 331356 and then get a taxi from Wincanton (approx 10 minutes).

By Car

From A303 (from London or Exeter directions)

Exit A303 approx 6 miles west of Wincanton or 1 mile east of Sparkford signposted North Cadbury, South Cadbury and Corton Denham.

If coming from London direction, turn left after leaving the slip road. From either direction turn right at the next T junction and go through South Cadbury passing the pub and the church on your right. Follow the road as it passes the car park for Cadbury Castle on your left. Ignore the first small left hand turn after the car park and take the next left signposted Sherborne and Corton Denham.

Go up the hill. Turn left at the next T junction towards Sherborne. You enter Corton Denham. Ignore the first, second and third left hand turns. After half a mile you will come to a no through road on your right (Ridge Lane).

Turn here, go down the incline passing some houses on your left. Look out for a wooden gate on your left with Wyndham Barns written on it.

If you end up at the church or the pub in Corton Denham you will have travelled too far. Retrace your steps until you see Ridge Lane on your left (not Middle Ridge Lane which is not the same!)

From A30 (Sherborne)

Leave Sherborne via the road signposted Wincanton (the B3145) off the A30 near the top of the town.

After about 2 miles you will see a red signpost ahead of you. Bear left here towards Corton Denham. Follow the road another mile and a half until it narrows and you come to a T junction.

Turn left here and then right at the T junction at the bottom of the hill. Go on through the village of Corton Denham, passing the pub on your left and the church on your right. Ignore Middle Ridge Lane on your left. After a quarter of a mile you will see a no through road on your left (Ridge Lane).

Turn here, go down the incline passing some houses on your left. Look out for a wooden gate on your left with Wyndham Barns written on it.

If you end up at Whitcombe Farm Lane or Sutton Montis you have gone too far – retrace your steps or call for help!

Approximate Journey Times by car:

Central London - 2 ½ hours, Heathrow Airport – 2 hours

Exeter – 1 hour, Salisbury – 1 hour, Sherborne – 10 mins
